The **IACS Library**, established with the very inception of the Association way back in 1876, till date is one of the richest scientific research library in the eastern India giving vital backbone support to the scientific research community of the region. IACS Library has a modern modular library building of nearly 15,000 sq. ft floor area with all concerned ICT infrastructure and Internet and intranet facilities with support of LibSys Library Automation Software and DSpace Open Source Software.

The library has holdings of 81,000+ comprises of bound periodicals and books. As a consequences progressive metamorphosis of global ICT trend and its influence on the e-publishing of scholarly domain, the IACS library has also its sharp transition from printed journals to online e-journals & databases from 2010/11 onwards. Today IACS library has unlimited online access of more than 6000+ e-journals and [major global publishers line ACS, RSC, IOP, APS, AIP, CAS, Thomson (web of Science), Elsevier, Springer, Wiley, T & F etc.] from the DST/CSIR National Level Consortium platform called NKRC.

The Association Library, a grand repository in the field of basic sciences of valuable collection of rare scientific journals of historical importance as well as currently subscribed core scientific online journals and major online bibliographic and citation analysis databases extended its services to the Association Members [Life & Ordinary], Temporary Members of the Library and Members of the Indian Physical Society, besides its own Faculty Members, Scholars and Staff Members. Open access facilities to library resources [both conventional printed resources (mainly Books/Ref. Materials) and online resources (e-journals & databases)] are extended to all the valid users of the Library.
