Abstract:	In this non-technical talk, the history and evolution of modern science in India will be broadly surveyed. After a brief introduction, the introduction of scientific processes by the British will be mentioned, and followed by a mention of the spread of western education. The contributions of pioneering Indian scientists in the colonial period will then be described. Finally, the growth of major scientific and technological institutions in post-independence India will be outlined.
About the Speaker:	Sreerup Raychaudhuri is a theoretical physicist who works on the physics of elementary particles and their interactions. He is a Ph.D. from the University of Calcutta and worked as a postdoc at TIFR and CERN. He taught Physics at IIT Kanpur for several years before joining TIFR where he is now a Professor. His research interests lie in interfacing theory with experiments, especially in the physics of electroweak interactions. He is also interested in the popularisation and history of science, especially in India.
